




## Trends in society lead to <u>skill gaps</u> in European labour market(s)

will relate to high-skilled occupations




# By 2030, 43% of the job openings will require high qualifications






## **Structure of ESCO: three pillars**

## Structure of the skills pillar

#### Skills hierarchy

Four distinct subclassifications targeting different types of concepts

Each of the 13,485 concepts to be classified to only one group Knowledge: 2 837 concepts grouped to ISCED-F's 80 fields

Attitudes & values: current structure as starting point

Language skills & knowledge: current structure as starting point





  - Quality of input text






## **Use of ESCO in The New Europass**

#### Main components of the Europass platform Overview






## Use of ESCO in EU skills panorama
